The Kane County Children's Justice Center is here to serve children and families who are experiencing the crisis and chaos that comes with the disclosure of physical or sexual abuse of a child. The center is designed to help children feel safe and comfortable so that they may begin to deal with the difficult issues that surround abuse.

We have been raising funds for our permanent Children's Justice Center location. Construction began in July and will be complete in January of 2020. The new center is located north of the Kane County Hospital on Main Street. However, we still need funds for final construction costs as well as for ongoing services for the children and families that come to the center.
